I need a new or good condition magneto sprocket for my 1927 Flying Squirrel. Last year I bought a PM1R BTH Magneto from Rexton for my bike. It works great! The shaft was a little bigger than my original so I hand reamed my sprocket to fit the taper. Needless to say, I have a little wobble. I measured the shaft as .525" at the big end, .425" at the small end and .5" in length. Anyone know the specs of the stock sprocket? I believe it to be a 20tooth with a 1/2" pitch, but I'm not sure of the width. Rexton may be able to source a sprocket for me, if given the correct specs. Thanks for any help locating a proper sproket.
